

Registration Information for Students Transferring from Another School

When registering students transferring from another school we will need the name of the school and the city where it is located, along with other information including emergency contact information. We are usually able to obtain a copy of the birth certificate and immunizations from the transferring school. If the school is unable to provide us with the information, we will request the documents from the parents/guardians before enrollment is complete. All registration paperwork must be turned in by noon in order for the new student to start the next class day.

Registration for 2010-2011 School Year

Please plan to register your Kindergartner March 22-25, 2010. Registering this week helps us plan for next year.

- To be eligible to begin Kindergarten, your child must be 5 years old by midnight August 31, 2010.
- When registering, please bring your students **birth certificate, current immunization information and your new kindergartner.** These documents are required before your Kindergartner can begin school in the Snohomish School District.
- Registration for the all day kindergarten program will also be done at this time. If we have more students register than spaces will allow for, a lottery system will be used for placement.
- The Full Day Kindergarten Program is funded by a tuition fee that pays the difference between the state-funded half-day program and the Full Day program. The tuition fee for the 2009-2010 school year will be \$2,900 with several payment options available, including a payment of \$271.50 for 10 months thru an automatic bank withdrawal. More information regarding the 2010-2011 school year's tuition rate will be available in March.
- We do offer some scholarships and reduced tuition for families that qualify for the free or reduced price lunch program.
